Heathcote is a non-selective independent co-educational day school for children aged 2-11, located in the village of Danbury, just outside Chelmsford. The school was founded in 1935 by the Heath family. In 2018 the School was sold to the Heather Partnership.

Heathcote is an exceptionally warm and friendly place to learn where excellence is at the heart of all we do. Working as a team we foster a love of lifelong learning whilst at the same time encouraging all our community to be curious, appreciative and respectful towards the world around them. As a small, friendly and happy school we are proud of the warmth, progressive approach and individualised learning every pupil receives. Each day every member of our staff seeks to make a difference to the lives of our children. Our mission is to ensure that every pupil recognises their own self-worth and through their school journey they build character, confidence and compassion as well as a solid academic foundation. General Duties

It is expected that all members of staff will work together to help further the school's aims and objectives in accordance with policies.

A cleaning rota will be devised of daily, weekly, half termly and termly jobs to complete but includes:

Daily clean:

- Toilets
- All classrooms and communal areas
- Emptying bins
- High contact areas
- Offices

Deep cleans:

- Carpet/Floor cleans
- Window cleans
- Oven and fridge cleans

Closing of the school including checking all lights and heaters are switched off and all doors are locked
