Equipment

Children do not need to bring any equipment to school until they enter Year 3. However, they have their own named trays in which to store any items they do wish to bring.

Year 3

- Good quality soft rubber
- Perspex ruler with cm. and mm. markings – 30cm in length – not flexible
- Two good HB pencils
- A set of coloured pencils
- A set of felt tip pens (fine at one end and broad at the other)

- A pencil sharpener with container for sharpening
- A pair of scissors (not pointed please)
- 2 x glue sticks
- Simple dictionary – Oxford or Collins pocket size
- Pink, purple and green pens (fine) gel or biro but not felt (for self marking)

Year 4 (In addition to the above):

- A calculator (simple, with large clear number buttons, % and square root functions and memory buttons)
- 180 protractor – clear in order to see through it

Year 5 and 6 (In addition to the above):

- Highlighters
- Thesaurus
- More advanced dictionary
- **Please note:** Any missing equipment supplied by the school will be charged at cost and added to your bill.

Other

Jewellery

Children should not wear jewellery of any kind, including earrings. Allowances may be made for items with religious meaning (please speak to the Headteacher regarding this) but the child should be able to remove them for break and PE.

Watches are acceptable (not smart watches), however they must also be removed prior to playing sport and during PE lessons.

Hair

Hair below the shoulder should be tied back tidily out of the face using a white or blue fixing. Shaved hair should be no shorter than a number 3 with no fashion shaved patterns, shaved sides or shaved sections.

Dyed hair is not acceptable.

The school would ask parents to check any anomalies with the HT before having the pupils hair cut if concerned.

Smart devices

No smart devices of any kind or items of high value should be brought into school. Where there is a need to bring such items, this should be agreed in advance with the Headteacher and stored securely in the office.
